#### Vacation care

Here at Eden Hills OSHC, we offer care for your children during the school holidays. We are open from 7.30am, right through to 6.15pm. We provide breakfast until 8.30am. We ask that you provide their recess and lunch, like a normal school day, except when lunch is being offered from the OSHC.



At 3.30pm the OSHC will provide the students with a nutritious snack consisting of fruit and vegetables along with a special snack which can range from Fruit bread to Sausage rolls and Spring rolls. And of course, we can't forget our famous Milo and Biscuit tradition around 4.30pm. Our vacation care program is about the students having fun, enjoying time with their peers, whilst learning through play that meets and is enriched around our two curriculums.

# The Program

The Eden Hills OSHC Program is constructed following the Reggio Emelia approach. It supports all children's learning stages and helps them reach their full potential. Staff and students work together to offer the activities and experiences. We believe that children learn their best when given agency to create experiential learning for themselves, guided by a program based on My Time Our Place and the Early Years Learning Framework. It offers a holistic balance of physical, creative, social emotional, cognitive experiences every day. We use a learning management system called Seesaw in conjunction with the school. Using the app allows you to see your child/children's learning throughout the day.

### Menu

We offer meals for each session.

- Before school offers breakfast, inclusive of cereals, toast and juice.
- After school care offers an afternoon tea as they arrive: 3.10pm-3.30pm. This can consist of fresh fruit, crackers, popcorn, etc.
- On Fridays, students are provided an ice block as a special treat to finish off the week.

During vacation care, we ask you to pack the same as a regular kindy day: packed recess, and lunch plus extra as we are very active and having fun. We still provide our usual menu with a little added extra breakfast until **8.30am**.

## **How to Enrol**

All parents must complete an enrolment form before starting, Forms are available through the OSHC office or can be emailed directly

There will be a \$14 fee for a red OSHC hat. This will be used only within OSHC, for easy identification for our educators and teachers.

You will need to download the Spike Childcare App and the QKR app on your phone, which helps with bookings and other information. The staff will go thought this with you once you have commenced.

All fees are paid through the QKR app, or in the OSHC office via Eftpos.

Note: we are limited to 8 Kindergarten child placements each afternoon session.
